Setting Stones in Art Clay Silver

Learn a new method of setting faceted stones in Art Clay Silver that creates a more professional look than the old build-up technique. This technique is also easier! (B-I)

16ga Sterling Wire: 480316

Fire in Place Stones:

Garnet, Moonstone, Sapphire of any Color, Ruby, Emerald (plus others)
