Fidget Ring

You'll never be bored once you make one of these cool rings. The outer band is contained by the shoulders of the inner band, but free to turn. Sometimes called a spinner ring. (I)

Supplies Required:

20ga sterling silver sheet, approx. ½" wide x 3"

Wire for spinning ring

Solder, hard-med-easy

Tools Used:

Ring mandrel-metal

Ring clamp

Ring mandrel holder

Chasing hammer

Domed head chasing hammer

Rawhide hammer/non-marring hammer

Dapping punches, larger sizes

Bench Block

Cross-peen hammer

Jeweler's Saw

Sawblades, 3/0 or 2/0

Bur Lube

Files

Miter Cutting Vise

Torch

Soldering Station

Solder Pick

Tweezers

Copper Tongs

Glass Quench container, approx. 16 oz

Magnification

Portable Ott Light



A note on cost of supplies -

We prefer not to offer kits for our classes. We try to encourage students to pick equipment and supplies (stones, beads etc.) based on their individual creativity. Often there are several options available and you may have some items already. If you are new to jewelry making, you are welcome to use the shop's tools so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! New students will share the shop tools between them.

Note- this list is designed to help you determine what to bring from home. Not everything is required, and we STRONGLY recommend not buying anything before class if you don't already have it. Many times there are factors that will determine your best choice and we will discuss all this at class. Bring what you have, and don't stress about what you don't.
