Sawing Jumprings

Are you tired of paying for hundreds of jumprings to make a byzantine bracelet like the one pictured? Or do you just want to be able to quickly make whatever size jumpring you want when you need it? This class will teach you to coil and saw your own jump rings from plain wire.



Supplies Required:

16ga wire (copper, silver or brass)

-or-

20ga silver wire if making links for Silver Multi Link Bracelet class

Tools Required:

Dowel assortment or bamboo knitting needles

Jeweler's saw

2/0, 3/0 or 4/0 blades

Bur lube

Duck billed pliers

Nylon jaw pliers

A note on cost of supplies -

We prefer not to offer kits for our classes. We try to encourage students to pick equipment and supplies (stones, beads etc.) based on their individual creativity. Often there are several options available and you may have some items already. If this is your first class, you are welcome to use the shop's tools so you can discover how enjoyable it can be! New students will need to share the shop tools between them. **It is important to remember to always bring your tools from home!**

White diamond polishing compound: 347448
