Silver Bezel Ring

Come to class and make yourself a great ring! In this class, we'll make every piece of this great ring from beginning to end. We'll learn soldering and how to make a bezel setting. You'll set your stone and do a bit of polishing before heading home with a finished ring. As with so many classes, this one often runs long so be prepared to spend a little extra time at the store if necessary.

Please bring your own torch (if you have one) along with any of the tools listed below that you may have. (B)

Prerequisites: None although it will help if you have a knowledge of sawing, filing and sanding.

Cabachon- 6mm Round or 8x6 oval or larger, hard stone

Sterling Sheet 20GA or 22GA: 480120, 480122

4x1 Rectangle Silver Wire: 480020

Bezel Strip to fit stone
