Viking Knit Bracelet

This technique of knitting wire is useful for making flexible necklaces and bracelets. The Viking knit provides a big look in silver without a lot of weight to drive up the price. (B)



Supplies Required:

24GA wire, 25' sterling, copper, brass or craft: 480424
Clasp of your choice
End caps or cones: 481604

Approx. Supplies Cost: \$20 and up

Additional Tools:

Hex Wrench Set 1/4" - 1/2"
Ice Pick

Approx Tools Cost: \$15
